
Flood Inundated Areas in Part of Assam State

Based on the analysis of ALOS-2 PALSAR satellite data of 25-May-2022 (1100 HRS IST)







About the Event

Floods were reported in Assam due to heavy rains followed by rise in water levels of Brahmaputra & its tributaries during the third week of May, 2022. According to ASDMA, Govt. of Assam, Dima Hasao is the worst affected district in current spell followed by Nagaon, Hojai and Barak valley districts. According to Central Water Commission, River Kopili at Kampur in Nagaon district, is reported to be flowing in extreme flood situation. Many other tributaries of Brahmaputra river are flowing in severe flood situation (Source: CWC, newsmedia)




