IV. Step-3 Activities for covering entire DRR cycle

The <u>Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030</u> was adopted with a suggestion to <u>better use of space based data and GIS for Risk identification and for risk mitigation and reduction</u>. It is suggested that Sentinel Asia could enhance its capacities for risk assessment and early warning to flood, landslide, wildfire and tsunami.

Action Items

- Identify risk elements using Sentinel Asia Data (<u>mapping risk elements</u>)
- > Promote disaster monitoring, post disaster monitoring and damage assessment
- ➤ Promote knowledge, experience and practical knowledge development through networks; user, DAN and university network
- > Align with Sendai Framework to link Sentinel Asia with global forum
- ➤ Use Sentinel Asia Working Group activities to develop necessary support for Sentinel Asia activities to cover entire disaster phase.

Contribution, planned and expected

- 1. Coordinate with donor agencies for supporting Sentinel Asia activities
 - Raising project fund from business communities
- 2. Promote collaboration with international organizations
 - Develop funding mechanisms to support R&Ds as UNESCAP program
- 3. Promote collaboration with universities for program development
 - Invite University of Tokyo, Graduate School of Public Policy to develop the funding program
- 4. Promote collaboration with business communities
 - Facilitate DRR as new business opportunities

Collaboration from others (partners, local agencies and etc.)

- Make suggestion in planning the Program framework, including mechanism for evaluation and reporting
- Apply the Program with relevant partners to promote expansion of Sentinel Asia activities for covering the complete DRR phases
