

- (1) GLOF in Humla, Nepal on 15 May, 2025 (GLIDE Number <u>FF-2025-000065-NPL</u>)


Nepalkhabar reported that two glacial lakes in Nepal's Humla District burst on 15 May, triggering flash floods. Five bridges were swept away, and 32 residents were relocated to a safer area after their homes were damaged.




(2) Flood and Landslide in Northern Vietnam on 18 May, 2025 (GLIDE Number <u>FL-2025-000066-VNM</u>)

Vietnam's northern area suffered heavy rain on 17 and 18 May. According to the Asia News Network dated 20 May, Lai Châu Province reported five deaths and four injuries, while Bắc Kạn Province confirmed four deaths and three injuries.



(3) Flood and Landslide in Central Vietnam on 25 May, 2025 (GLIDE Number <u>FL-2025-000069-VNM</u>)







(4) Oil and Chemical spill in India on 25 May, 2025 (GLIDE Number AC-2025-000070-IND)

On 25 May, a cargo ship carrying oil and hazardous materials capsized and sank off the coast of Kerala state in southern India, according to the BBC. All 24 crew members on board were rescued, but some of the ship's 640 containers have drifted toward the shore, prompting the evacuation of nearby residents. Oil, fuel, and other chemical substances have leaked, raising concerns about potential environmental damage.

2. Sentinel Asia Annual Report 2023 has been issued

Sentinel Asia's activity report for 2023 has been published. In 2023, Sentinel Asia received 27 Emergency Observation Requests from its Joint Team Project (JPT) members.

The report features, among others, (i) a detailed review on EORs conducted in 2023 including good practices; (ii) external relations such as news, publications, and reports on conferences; and (iii) an analytical survey of Sentinel Asia's operations.

After the COVID-19 pandemic subsided, the Sentinel Asia JPT Meeting (JPTM) was held in September 2023 at the Indonesian National Research and Innovation Agency (BRIN) in Jakarta, Indonesia. The 8th JPTM, which was held for the first time in about four years since the meeting held in Thailand in November 2019, was attended by 85 people from 35 institutions, who shared their activities and other information.
